- Use the toilet by myself.



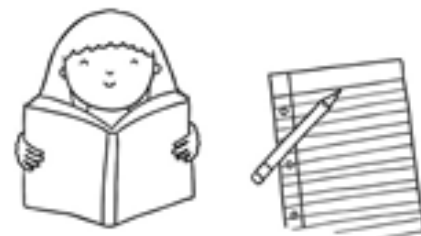
- Use a knife and fork.
