Learning at Heatherside

Children in YR are taught in three classes, following the Early Years Foundation Stage framework.



Early Years (YR)

Teachers set up areas of learning across both the indoor classroom and outdoors, which offer engaging learning opportunities for all areas of the curriculum





Throughout the day, children work one to one or in small groups with their teacher or learning support assistant, with a particular focus being given to reading phonics, writing and maths.

In Y1 and Y2 the children continue to learn through engaging and inspirational experiences. These are built into the curriculum through carefully planned topics.

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Key Stage 1 (Y1 & Y2)



We create learning opportunities both indoors and outdoors for the children, which bring together all areas of the curriculum and are presented in creative and exciting ways.

This approach is stimulating and motivates the children to learn, where enjoyment and achievement go hand in hand.
