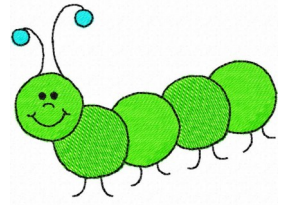




What we would like you to do each day...



Start the week by sharing our focus story
(as indicated on the middle of our weekly plan)

Then choose one literacy activity and one numeracy activity from the plan to complete each day.

These activities are to be led and supported by you. When writing please use the sounds mat and refer to the letter formation guide.

Each day your child can have a go at these activities independently

- ♦ Practise your phonics by playing either 'Space Race' or 'Rocket Rescue' on **Phonics Play**. Start with Phase 2 and move onto Phase 3 when ready.

- ♦ Count forwards and backwards to 20 and play some maths games on **EducationCity.com** (Subjects/Mathematics/F2/Activities)
- ♦ Also choose games from the websites listed on our **Useful Websites page**
- ♦ Choose 4 words you would like to learn from your Phase word list and make a matching pairs game with them.
- ♦ Choose 1 **Challenge Bingo activity to complete.**

We would love to see what your child has been doing so we would ask that you keep the work they have done. Perhaps take a few photos and make it into a 'special scrapbook' to share with us when things go back to normal. (This can be as simple as stapling the work together)

Remember that a lot of learning takes place through their own play. It is very important that in addition to the directed tasks we have set above that everyday your child follows their own play ideas and activities too. This is important to let their imaginations develop!
