Reading skills:

- Sounding out and blending more complex words
- Chunking words into syllables
- Using the context of the sentence to decode new words
- Comprehension skills

Writing skills:

- Grammar; word types and sentence types
- Spelling Y2 Common Exception Words
- Punctuation . , ? !

Maths:

- Calculations: addition and subtraction, multiplication (2,5 and 10 times tables), division, plus how they link together (inverse operations)
- Rapid recall of number facts e.g.; addition and subtraction within 20 and number bonds
- Problem solving

- notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults
- find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)
- describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene

Computing: Multimedia

- use technology purposefully to create, store and manipulate digital content
- Use technology safely and respectfully

Geography: Human and physical features of the school environment

- Use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment

History: Mary Anning

- Learn about the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements

Art: Clay models

- To use a range of materials creatively to design and make products;
- To develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space
