Daily reading

Please continue to ask your child read as often as possible, regardless of their reading level, to develop their fluency. As a guide, a fluent reader in Year 2 will be able to read around 80—95 words a minute. In school, children's fluency when reading is assessed alongside their knowledge and application of phonics and the five domains of comprehension.

Periodically, please go over the common exception words from previous lists to embed these spellings so that your child can spell them correctly in their everyday writing.
