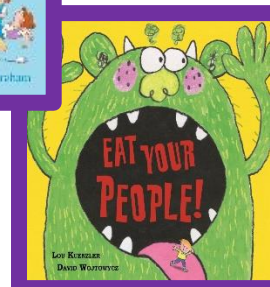
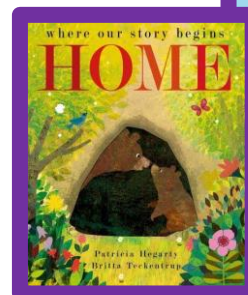

| Develop a love of reading at home by reading a book with your child as frequently as possible (aiming for 3 times a week minimum).<br>Practise phonics every week. | Remember to include capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks in your writing.<br>Make sure you are using a finger space in between each word. | Practise addition and subtraction number facts for all numbers to 10 and then 20, e.g. $6+4=10$ , $16+4=20$ .<br>Practise 1 more and 1 less, counting in tens and twos forward and back. | Practise handwriting, making sure you are holding the pencil in the correct tripod grip and all your letters and numbers are the correct size and round the right way. |

In **reading** we will sound out and blend more complex words, chunk words into syllables and decode new words. In **writing** we will practise saying and writing sentences neatly using the correct punctuation and have a look at rhyming words. We will practise spelling the Year 1 Common Exception words and write dictated sentences.

As **Mathematicians** we will be practising number facts using both addition and subtraction to 20 and securing place value knowledge. We will look at 2D & 3D shape, length and height, mass and weight. Across all these we will be applying our skills to solve calculations and word problems.

In **PSHE** we will examine what it means to 'belong', explore friendship, bullying and who a trusted adult is and when we might need one. We will also name and discuss part of the body including which parts are private.

In **Geography** we will be examining locational knowledge, looking at our school and Fleet and comparing it with the Jurassic coast line of Lyme Regis, we will also find out about the 4 counties within the UK.



In **science** we will be exploring what pets need, different habitats and homes, we will also look at ourselves, changes and our senses.

Our **music** skills will be developed through exploring 'pulse', examining pulse in songs and movement and then progressing to using both voice and instruments to maintain, change and control pulse.

As **artists** we will study spirals, look at artist Molly Haslund and learn how to use a sketchbook. Create drawings using whole body, use a wide range of materials, explore linework, colour blending, mark making and scale.

In **PE** we will be moving and dancing to music and practising our fitness skills. We will also learn ball skills.

During **computer** sessions we will be using an 'app' to 'paint', also, programming beebots and learning about algorithms and de-bugging.

During **RE** we will be exploring different celebrations and the idea of thankfulness. We will look at how Christians celebrate Harvest and recognise what a celebration is and what the features of a celebration might be.
